Effective October 1, 2010, Ford will be moving its retirement processing administration to a new service provider. As part of this transition, you will have access to your pension plan benefit information on the [myfordbenefits.com](http://myfordbenefits.com) Web site.

## Drive Wealth – Pension Plan Benefit

Beginning October 1, 2010, the **myfordbenefits.com** Web site will allow you to view your pension plan benefit information and take advantage of self-service tools under the Pension tab of **Drive Wealth**.

Through the secure Web site, you will have access to self-service pension plan benefit capabilities 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The Web site will enable you to quickly and easily complete transactions online throughout the year, and access information about your benefit at any time.

### What you can do online:

Beginning on October 1, 2010, you will be able to:

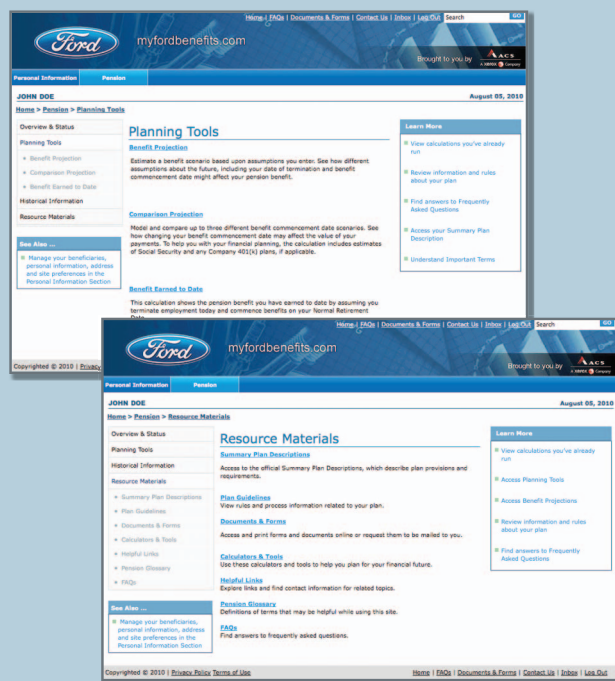
- Review **Overview & Status** to see your pension plan benefit information.

  - > Add/update direct deposit and tax withholding
  - > Request pension benefit verification
- Review **Historical Information**, such as confirmation history for online transactions.

### Contacting the National Employee Services Center (NESC):

If you need to call the NESC, your User ID for the phone system will continue to be your Social Security Number. You may not use an alternative User ID for telephone access. Your PIN, however, will be the same for both the Web site and the NESC.
